

Parc le Breos House Access Statement

We aim to, ensure, that all our guests have comfortable facilities, all requests are dealt with efficiently and all guests are made to feel welcome throughout their stay. We do recommend that wheel chair users are accompanied by a family member, friend, partner or carer.

- There is a drop off point outside main reception, although surface consists of stone chippings, which may be unstable for some people.
- Entry to the hotel via 2 small steps leading to front door (110cm in width).
- The reception area has seating for guests to wait.
- The whole of the ground floor of Parc-Le-Breos is accessible to wheelchairs – as is much of the surrounding gardens and terrace.
- Alternative entrance at rear of property, no step, 90cm wide.
- There is a designated car parking space at the rear of the hotel which allows access to the ground floor reception rooms and bedrooms without the need to negotiate any steps.
- Someone is always available to assist guests with luggage.
- All doors and corridors are wide enough for wheelchairs, and zimmer frames.
- All corridors and public areas are well lit and have good colour contrasting.
- Three rooms are available on the ground floor. Rooms on first floor accessed via staircase. Staircase is at 110cm wide steps are 190mm in depth. The staircase has 19 steps to access first floor. There is also a hand rail for support.
- All rooms are en-suite. However none are modified specifically for disabled use.
- Doors have lever actions. Rooms have good colour contrasting and are well lit. All rooms have radio alarms and remote controls for televisions.
- Mobile phone networks available.
- Dining room has chairs with good back supports. Lounge has a selection of seating with good back support and arm rests.
- Lounge has large television with subtitles available.
- Information available in alternative forms by prior arrangement.
- Service dogs (only) are allowed in the hotel
- Special diets catered for by arrangement.
- Staff trained under the welcome host scheme.
- Fire exits clearly identified.
- The hotel does have a wheelchair available on a complementary basis for guests. Please advise the hotel before booking if you require a wheelchair.
